

Cadet of the Year

- All cadets of the quarter will be nominated for cadet of the year.
- Cadet board will interview the cadet of the quarter on the 1st Wednesday in June at 2:45pm at NAI.
- A scoring system will be used to select the cadet of the year
- Scoring will be as follows:
 - 0 – 15 points for activities within JROTC
 - 0 – 15 points for activities outside of JROTC
 - 0 – 5 points for employment
 - 1 – 10 points for the interview
- The interview will consist of a series of questions from the following topics:
 - Current events
 - Leadership Development
 - Aerospace Science (appropriate to aerospace science level)
- At the end of the interview the cadet nominated for cadet of the year will answer the final question:
 - Why do you believe that you should be selected as the PA-022 Cadet of the year.
- The board will consist of the Squadron Commander, Special Assistant to the SASI, Special Assistant to the ASI, and one cadet selected at random from NASH and NAI.
- Board members will NOT discuss the nomination with anybody.
- If any cadet on the board is nominated for the cadet of the year, they will not take part in the scoring.
- A cadet not nominated will be chosen by the ASI and will take that cadets place on the board.
- The total points from all 5 board members will be tallied and the cadet with the most points will be selected as the cadet of the year.
- In the event of a tie the Squadron commanders score will be used to select the cadet of the month.
- If the commander and any other member on the board are not scoring the following order will be used to break the tie.
 - Squadron Commander
 - Special Assistant to the SASI
 - Special Assistant to ASI
 - Cadet from NASH
 - Cadet From NAI
- The cadet of the year will have their name placed on a perpetual plaque and receive a \$100 gift certificate from the PA-022.
